1. State where (place) and when (date) the following contracts were concluded. In your answer you are expected to name the theory adopted in arriving at your answer.
 - 1.1 Jack, who lives in Cape Town, made an offer to Jill in Johannesburg on 24 April whereby he offered to sell his bucket to her for R20. On 27 April Jill telephoned Jack informing him that she accepted the offer. Jack was in Durban when he received Jill's call. (3)
 - 1.2 Allie lives in George and made an offer to sell goods to Muhammed. He prescribed that the response to the offer be made by post. Muhammed lives in Bellville and wrote his letter of acceptance on the 20th of May. He posted the acceptance on the 21st of May in Cape Town. Allie received and read the letter of acceptance on the 22nd of May in George. (3)
2. Explain in the following situations whether a valid offer/acceptance was made. In your answer you are expected to refer to the requirements for a valid offer/acceptance.
 - 2.1 Sharon tells Nomsa that she can buy one of her two televisions. (2)
 - 2.2 Joost informs Stefan that he will buy the rugby tickets but insists that the price be reduced. (2)
 - 2.3 Sharon writes a letter to Nomsa in which she states that Nomsa may buy her car. The letter however, never reaches Nomsa. (2)
 - 2.4 Andile posts a notice on the University notice board whereby he offers R1000 to anyone who returns his Rolex watch undamaged. (2)
